Camp Registration

Registration Opens March 18, 2020 at 7:00am

Camps require registration plus submission of this completed Camp Package (including waiver and medical form) within one week of registration. You may register by phone at **204-632-3900**, online at wellnessinstitute.ca, through the Wellness Institute app or in person at 1075 Leila Avenue. You may fax, mail, or drop off your completed Camp Package in person. The Wellness Institute is not responsible for lost, delayed, or failed mail or fax transmissions. Payment **MUST** be received and completed Camp Package submitted before processing of your registration will occur.

Payment & Refunds

We accept cash, Interac, Visa and MasterCard. Personal cheques will not be accepted. Refunds will only be issued up to one week prior to the commencement of the program and are subject to a \$25 administration fee.

Attending Camp

Drop-off & Pick Up

You may drop your children off in Wellness Room 4 between 8:00am and 9:00am and pick them up between 4:00pm and 5:00pm. While there is supervision during these times, there are no structured activities. Parents are asked to sign their child in and out each day. Written notification must be provided if someone else is picking up your child. Proof of identification will be required at time of pick up.

Arrangements for early drop-off or late pick-up may be made at an additional cost by calling 204-632-3913, in advance.

Absenteeism

If your child is unable to attend camp, please inform us as soon as possible by calling 204-632-3900.

Lunch

All children must bring a lunch and snacks. Please note that the children will not have access to a microwave. Due to the increasing number of life-threatening allergies to nuts and peanut butter, we kindly ask that you respect our no-nut policy. An age-appropriate movie will be shown during lunch.

Lost and Found

There will be a lost and found located in Room 4. Please check the box to be sure your child has not forgotten any belongings. The Wellness Institute is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

Behaviour Expectations

We expect all campers to be respectful to others at all times, providing a safe and positive Day Camp experience for all campers. All campers are expected to follow camp rules and guidelines. When guidelines and rules are not adhered to, campers will be spoken to and may be provided with some form of consequence to help with understanding and prevention of future problems. Safety of all campers is always paramount. You will be notified immediately of any disciplinary problems with your child that cannot be rectified and/or threatens the safety of others.

Activities & Participation

Swimming

Campers will swim 4-5 days per week so please send a bathing suit and towel with your child every day. Each child will have their swimming ability evaluated to determine whether or not they are allowed in the deep end of the pool and/or require a life jacket. The Wellness Institute will supply life jackets to those who require them.

Special Assistance

All children may attend and fully participate regardless of ability. If your child requires special assistance to participate in camp activities, you must provide an attendant (at no added charge).
